



Dear Parent,

In accordance with your request, we are pleased to enclose our Gan Alonim Day Camp scholarship application.

Please note our policies and philosophies regarding scholarships: Gan Alonim Day Camp is a non-profit organization which is not affiliated with or subsidized by a Jewish community agency or movement. We are able to raise a small amount of scholarship funds from generous families, but the bulk of scholarship awards come from the camp's operating budget. An anonymous committee determines who is eligible to receive aid based solely on need. Please note our new policy: **All scholarship applications must be received by March 15, 2010.** The scholarship committee will review all applications shortly after this date. You will receive notification about your application within two weeks after review.

It is our policy to give aid not exceeding 25% of the cost of tuition for a single child. This applies only to tuition for days at camp and does not include bus or swimming lesson fees. So that we may help as many families as possible, we ask that you only request the amount that is absolutely necessary for your child(ren) to attend camp.

Your application will only be considered complete when the following have been received:

1. A summer 2010 Gan Alonim enrollment form accompanied by the \$100 deposit.
2. A completed scholarship application.
3. A copy of your 2008 or 2009 tax return.
4. Two references (only applicable if your child is new to Gan Alonim). Please understand that it is your responsibility to follow up and make sure the references are mailed or faxed to our office.
5. A letter on a separate piece of paper stating the reason for your scholarship request and anything that you think the scholarship committee should know regarding your request.

Payment plans may be arranged through the camp office once scholarships have been awarded. All tuition must be paid before June 1, 2010.

In keeping with the highest levels of *tzedakah*, it is our goal not only to honor your confidentiality, but also to honor you as a valued member of the Gan Alonim family. Although we must require certain documentation to process your request, it is not the committee's intention to embarrass any of our families. Our committee is dedicated to helping as many campers as possible which means that all families who receive aid are those who are truly in need.
